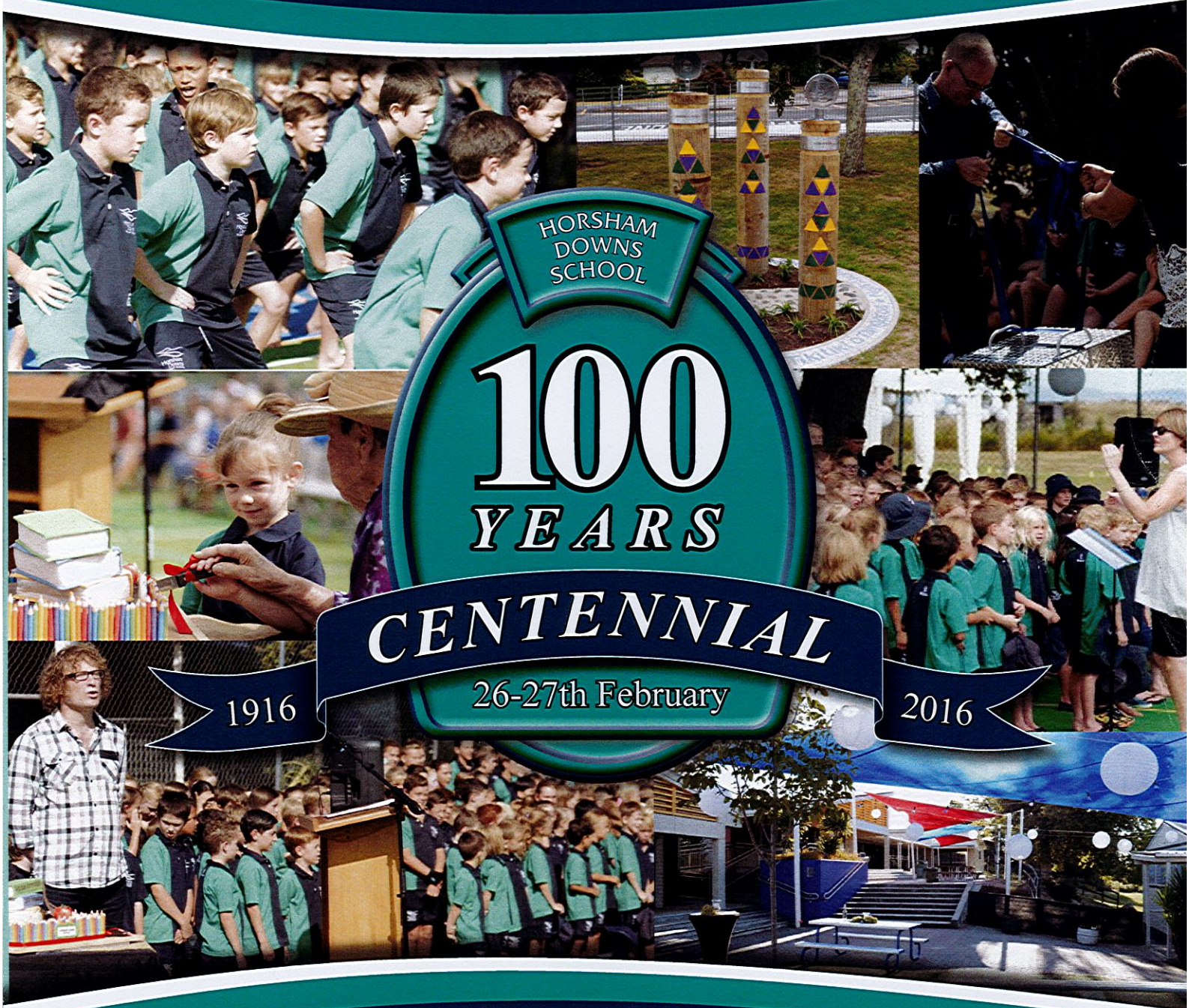

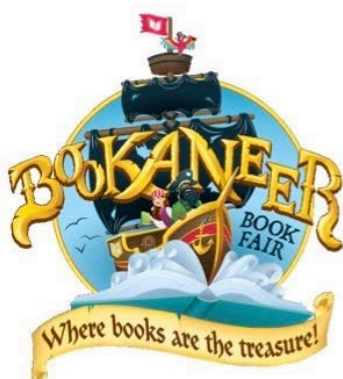

Use the **link** that has been given to you to access the survey. The link works best using **Firefox, Safari, Chrome**. Please avoid using Internet Explorer.

When you click on the link you will be taken to the opening page of the survey where you will be asked to select your role and then you will be provided with some background information about the survey.

You will then see the following option.

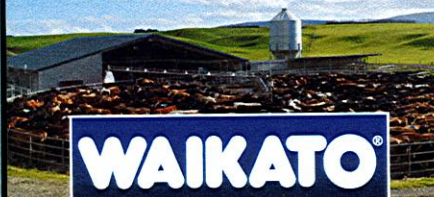
